MINUTES OF MEETING OF BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES OF CLAY COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

A Special Session of the Clay Community Schools Board of Trustees was held at the Central Administrative Office, 1013 S. Forest Avenue, Brazil, IN 47834, on Wednesday, May 20, 2015. Tom Reberger, Kevin Kumpf, Scott Hill, Fred Froderman, Ron Scherb, and Amy Burke Adams were present. Shane Wiram was absent.

I. Call to Order

The special session meeting was called to order at 7:38 p.m. by board president Ron Scherb.

II. Feasibility Study

Tom Neff of Schmidt Associates presented information regarding the feasibility study which had recently been conducted by his firm. The information covered the timeline, the facility assessments and findings, space needs, discussions with staff, and what to do with the information. III. Breakfast/Lunch Prices for 2015-16

It was recommended by Director of Personnel, Data, and Food Services Carolyn Kumpf that lunch prices for the elementary and secondary grades should be increased by \$0.10 to comply with the USDA requirement to increase lunch prices by at least \$0.10 per year until the school corporation's prices meet the Paid Reimbursable cost of \$2.70. It was also recommended that adult lunch prices be increased by \$0.10. The following table shows the recommended breakfast/lunch prices for 2015-16.
