# MINUTES OF MEETING OF BOARD OF SCHOOL TRUSTEES OF CLAY COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

A Special Session of the Clay Community Schools Board of Trustees was held at North Clay Middle School, 3450 W State Road 340, Brazil, IN 47834, on Monday, September 12, 2011. Tammy Beasley, Tina Heffner, Forrest Buell, Rob Miller, Ron Scherb, and Amy Burke Adams were present. Jennifer Kaelber was absent.

#### I. Call to Order

The special session meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m. by board president Rob Miller. Prior to conducting business, Mr. Miller asked for a moment of silence in remembrance of Christian Watkins.

# II. Adopt 2012 Budget, Capital Projects Plan, School Bus Replacement Plan and Levy Neutrality

With no discussion, Mrs. Heffner moved to accept the 2012 budget, capital projects plan, school bus replacement plan and levy neutrality. Mrs. Adams seconded, and the motion was approved by a 6-0 vote.

#### III. Classified Handbook Revisions: Second Reading

Mrs. Adams moved to accept the second reading of the classified handbook. Mrs. Beasley seconded, and the motion was approved by a 6-0 vote.

# IV. Bus Driver Handbook Revisions: Second Reading

Mrs. Adams moved to accept the second reading of the bus driver handbook. Mr. Scherb seconded, and the motion was approved by a 6-0 vote.

## V. Approval of School Improvement Plans

Superintendent Tucker stated that Indiana Code and Indiana Administrative Code provide that all accredited Indiana schools are required to maintain a school improvement plan that "lays out objectives for a three (3) year period" (511 IAC 6.2-3-1-1). This plan "must be annually reviewed and revised to accomplish the achievement objectives of the school" (511 IAC 6.2-3-1-2). Each school's improvement plan must be approved by their local superintendent and school board. Following local approval, the plan is required to be submitted to the Indiana Department of Education September 15<sup>th</sup> each year. Superintendent Tucker had received all of the plans and recommended approval so that the plans can be submitted to the Department of Education.

Mrs. Heffner moved to approve the plans and submit them to the Department of Education. Mrs. Adams seconded, and the motion was approved by a 6-0 vote.
